- 1. Archer meets academic guidelines qualifying as a 4<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grader.
- 2. Four consecutive absences of classes immediately prior to a tournament will make the archer ineligible to compete in that tournament.
- 3. Archer is enrolled and attending another class through Covenant Home School Resource Center per NASP rules.
- 4. To compete as a DATA team member in the NASP State Competition, the archer must participate in at least one qualifying archery tournament provided by AZ Game and Fish Dept.
- 5. Each archer family chooses and performs a job that supports and/or furthers the goals of the team.
